## **Admission Requirements**

- 3 years old by September 1
- Fully Toilet Trained
- Baptismal Certificate \*
- Record of Immunization
- Completed Registration Form

\* Baptismal certificates are only required for children *not* baptized at Shepherd of the Hills Parish.

Average class size is typically between 5 and 10 students.

## **Child Care**

Students enrolled in the child care may participate in the schools hot lunch program.

## **Bussing/Transportation**

At this time, 3K students are not eligible for bussing.

A parent or designated person is responsible for transportation of 3K students to and from Shepherd of the Hills.
