- Kindergarten Screening Evaluation
- Baptismal Certificate *
- Record of Immunization
- Completed of Health Forms
- Completed Registration Form

*Baptismal certificates are only required for children baptized outside of Shepherd of the Hills Parish.

Kindergarten Screening

All students entering the 5 year old Kindergarten program at Shepherd of the Hills must be screened. Screening takes place in the spring of the year. The screening assesses developmental readiness including verbal, motor and memory skills. Screenings last approximately one hour. Parents will receive a copy of the screening results in the mail. You may sign up for screening by calling the school office.

Child Care

Shepherd of the Hills offers Before and After School Child Care to students enrolled in the 3K-8 grade day school programs.

Child Care services are available from 6:30 AM until 5:30 PM Monday through Friday during the school year.

Bussing

The Johnson Bus Company provides transportation for students who live in the Shepherd of the Hills attendance area of Campbelsport School District.

Families who live outside of the Campbelsport School District (in the adjoining Plymouth and Elkhart/Glenbeulah School Districts) may be eligible for bussing through Shepherd of the Hills.
